## What Do We Know?

- ◆ The emphasis on effectiveness & the use of evidence-based decisions requires adoption of evidence-based practices.
- ◆ Practical guidelines for integrating evidence-based practices not always available
- ◆ Organizational climate is predictive of treatment satisfaction and counselor rapport
